- Working with Stewart's business units and with other risk functions to identify technology security requirements, using methods that may include risk and business impact assessments
- Prioritizing business security risks and developing mitigation strategies and plans
- Configuring and maintaining monitoring and alerting tools including executive and management dashboards and reporting
- Performing event and alert analysis and dispositions
- Managing incident and event resolution, coordinating communication and reporting
- Coordinating and completing security operations documentation
- Working with Stewart's IT department and members of the information security and compliance teams to identify, select and implement technical controls
- Developing security processes and procedures, and supports service-level agreements (SLAs) to ensure that security controls are managed and maintained
